**RESOLUTION TO ADD FIRST RESPONDERS
TO TRANSPORT PATIENTS IN AMBULANCE**

WHEREAS: 2015 Senate Bill 143 (Act 113) passed to **amend** Wisconsin Statute 256.01(9), 256.15(4)(a)(intro.) and 1., 256.15(4)(a) 2. And 256.15(4)(c); and to **create** 256.15(4)(a) 3. And 256.15(4)(e) and (f) of the statutes **relating to**: ambulance staffing by emergency medical technicians, certified respiratory care practitioners, and first responders


WHEREAS: The Town of Conover's Ambulance Service is staffed by emergency medical technicians (EMTs) and first responders


WHEREAS: Under 2015 Senate Bill 143 (Act 113), signed into law on November 11, 2015 and effective on November 13, 2015, the law provides greater flexibility as it will no longer require The Town of Conover's Ambulance Service to have two EMTs in order to be able to transport a patient in an ambulance

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Town of Conover, Vilas County, Wisconsin does hereby allow first responders to assist the Town of Conover Ambulance Service in transporting patients in the ambulance.

This resolution repeals any previous resolutions or ordinances pertaining to the Town of Conover's Ambulance Service requirement to have two EMTs transporting patients.
