

RESOLUTION 172-17
Town Board to Propose Exceeding the State Levy Limit
as per Sec. 66.0602 of WI Statutes
Town of Conover – Vilas County

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin has adopted levy limits on town, village, city and county levies for 2014 and thereafter under s. 66.0602 of Wis. Statutes;

Whereas, s. 66.0602 of Wis. Statutes limits the allowable local levy for 2017 to a percentage increase of no more than the greater of (a) **0%** of the 2017 payable 2018 adjusted actual levy as calculated under the state's levy limit law or (b) a percentage equal to the percent change in equalized value due to net new construction; which for the Town of Conover is .691 percent;


Whereas, the Town Board of the Town of Conover, Vilas County believes that for the 2017 tax levy (collected in 2018) it is in the town's best interest to exceed the state levy limit as described above by a greater percentage than .691;

Whereas, the Town of Conover, Vilas County 2016 payable 2017 adjusted actual levy is \$726,186; And further whereas the state law would limit the increase to \$5,018 for an allowable town tax levy of \$731,204 before adjustments, for 2017, collected in 2018.

Now Therefore the Town Board of the Town of Conover, Vilas County does hereby resolve, and order as follows:

1. The town board supports an increase in the town tax levy for 2017 that will exceed the state levy limit.
2. The town board directs that the question of increasing the town tax levy for 2017 (to be collected in 2018) by 18.71 percent, which would increase the town levy by \$136,829 for a total town tax levy of \$868,033 (not including debt service of \$140,018), shall be placed on the agenda for the Special Town Meeting to be held on Thursday, November 9, 2017 at 5:00 p.m.
