

Resolution 130-12
Town of Conover
County Communications Town (Conover)

WHEREAS, radio communications for emergency services including fire and ambulance has had numerous incidents of loss of audible communications, and

WHEREAS, there are several so called "dead spots" in the Vilas County area with Conover being a location of poor communications, and

WHEREAS, with the recent changing to narrow banding for such tower communications further causing problems, and

WHEREAS, Vilas County has approached the Town for putting up one of two towers to enhance the communications for all of the county, and

WHEREAS, paging with a system called "simulcast" which will allow the broadcast of a single transmission off of all towers that will virtually eliminate the dead spots, and

WHEREAS, focus has been made on putting the tower behind the Conover Center utilizing this facility with emergency power (generator) and housing for equipment, and

WHEREAS, it will benefit Conover as well as all of the county tremendously with no cost to the taxpayer,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Conover Town Board unanimously approved of this proposal at the April 10th meeting, and by this Resolution, the Town of Conover Board of Supervisors embraces this proposal and encourages the County Board to go ahead with plans for putting up a new Simulcast Tower at the Conover Center and allow the town's radio band to be placed upon it also.
