

Resolution 149-14
Town of Conover
Advisory Referendum

WHEREAS, a Special Town Meeting was called for December 1, 2014 by petition of a sufficient numbers of Conover Electors, and

WHEREAS, the electors made known their desire to increase the Town Board from a membership of 3 to a Town Board consisting of 5 members, and

WHEREAS, the decision given under Wisconsin Statute 60.21(1) is a decision and a procedure under ordinance within the powers of the town board, and

WHEREAS, the Conover Town Board has received various opinions on the topic since the petition, and

WHEREAS, the advisory question to be polled as follows:

Would you be in support of the Conover Town Board increasing its members from the current 2 Supervisors and Chairperson to 4 Supervisors and Town Chairperson?

BE IT RESOLVED, the Conover Town Board of the Town of Conover has ordered an “Advisory Referendum” to be placed on the ballot in 2015 to get a clear view on the desires of the community as a whole. This referendum request was made in a motion by Thomas Timken Jr., was seconded by Karl Jennrich and was carried.
