

TOWN PARK USE

1. Key can be picked up the day before for stocking the freezer or refrigerator
2. Facility includes hot water, dish soap, trash cans and liners – aluminum cans must be separated
3. Only a certain number of tables are in the pavilion area – balance are under the “Open Air Shelter”
4. The BBQ pit area has electricity as well as the open air shelter –
5. Indoor and outdoor restroom facilities will be stocked with tissue.
6. There is a chest freezer for keeping ice or freezing blocks of ice. (let Jim know if you want access more than 24 hours ahead for freezing ice blocks in your own containers)
7. The park facility is used every Wednesday evening by a group called “Freedom Eagles” so access is not allowed on Wednesday evening
8. Facility will be supplied with the 36 cup coffee urn that is used by the Recreation Association for their potluck meetings
9. The two large cattle watering binds (for holding canned beverages and ice) are available on site
10. Because of dead bolts, keys to the facility must be used in locking it after the event
11. Keys can be returned to the Town of Conover by placing the keys into a locked drop box that is attached to the double doors going into the Conover Center and the Clerk’s Office.
12. Trash shall be placed inside the building so that animals do not make a mess and the trash will be taken to the transfer station by the town’s highway department

Note: The small fee charged for the rental of the facility is basically for the electricity, the supplies (toilet tissue) and the additional work needed to clean up and dispose of waste left at the site after a rental.

13. Any other questions regarding the facility, shall be addressed to the town clerk in advance.
