

Ordinance 130-18

Town of Conover, Vilas County

Amendment to Chapter 8: Public Works: Road Construction

WHEREAS, Chapter 8 of the General Code concerning Road Construction to be amended in two (2) sections, and

WHEREAS, Section 8.04(6)(4) reads: (Roadbed): "All marsh, swamp, muck and peat material shall be removed from the area of roadway to insure a stable and sound foundation for road fill."

Should be amended to read: "All organic material such as (Amended 5/10/18): marsh, swamp, muck and peat material shall be removed from the area of roadway to insure a stable and sound foundation for road fill", and


WHEREAS, Section 8.04(7) reads: "SURFACE COURSE: Crushed aggregate for the base course shall be placed to a compacted depth of four (4) inches. The crushed aggregate base course shall be placed to a minimum width of twenty-four (24) feet. Cul-de- sacs shall have a roadbed radius of forty (40) feet."

Should be amended to read: "SURFACE COURSE: Crushed aggregate for the base course shall be placed to a compacted depth of six (6) inches. The crushed aggregate base course shall be placed to a minimum width of twenty-six (26) feet. Cul-de- sacs shall have a roadbed radius of forty (40) feet." SPECIFICATION OF ASPHALT: 2 ¼" Compact asphalt surface, TYPE-E1 with either a PG-58- 28 or PG 52-34 asphalt cement, 20' wide with a 3' crushed aggregate base course shoulder. (Amended 5/10/18),


THEREFORE, be it hereby ordained by the Town Board of the Town of Conover, Vilas County, WI, approves the amendments to clarify the Roadbed and Surface Course of Chapter 8: Public Works concerning Road Construction,

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication or posting by the town clerk as required pursuant to s. 60.80 Wi. Stats.
