

Ordinance 126-18

Town of Conover

Amendment to Chapter 12: Licenses & Permits

WHEREAS, SECTION 12.03.5(l)(1) READS: [Pertaining to Liquor Licenses] Active Use Required: (1) As a minimum requirement, each holder of a Class A or Class B Liquor and Fermented Malt Beverage License shall place the same in active use for a period of not less than 20 hours per week for 13 consecutive weeks within each license period, said period being July 1 through June 30 of the subsequent year, and

WHEREAS, Section 12.03.5(l)(1) of Chapter 12 of the General Code, **be amended to add exceptions for Active Use pertaining to natural disasters and/or catastrophes, that the town board may determine a viable option for the license holder, with a 1-year maximum timeframe to rebuild/renovate,**

THEREFORE, be it hereby ordained by the Town Board of the Town of Conover, Vilas County, WI, approves the amendment for exceptions to 'Active Use Required,'

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication or posting by the town clerk as required pursuant to s. 60.80 Wi. Stats.




